- Documentation clarifying all extensions of time agreed for the abstraction and impoundment licence applications and discharge consent applications.

- Documentation attached relates to Discharge Consents TrC 080/20 and TrC 081/20 clarifying extensions of time agreed.
- See attached note of a meeting held on 2 December 2019 which highlights that NIEA had informed the applicant of the intention to direct the applications to the Appeals Commission. See attached Ministerial Approval to direct Appeals commission to consider representations at a Public Local Inquiry given on the 20th November 2020 and a further communication to the Appeals Commission confirming NIEAs intention to direct the Appeals Commission under Regulation 17 of the Abstraction and Impoundment Licensing Regulations 2006 on 20th January 2021. NIEA had informed the applicant of its intention to direct Applications 2020/1050 and AIL 2020/1060 to the Appeals Commission. It was understood that this would necessarily mean that the applications would not be determined within the time limit set by regulation 19(1) once received. No extensions have therefore been requested for Applications 2020/1050 and AIL 2020/1060.
