In terms of taking forward the action will rest with myself.

Regarding timescales and completion of all formalities could take up to 9 months to complete. It usually takes around 2-3 months for Division to have a submission prepared to send to our HQ. This includes consultation with all Statutory Bodies and other Departments. HQ then prepare the relevant Notices and advertising etc. The advertising notice for receipt of objections is 6 weeks. If all goes according to plan then the 9 months would be a fair guesstimate for completion of formalities. Should an objection be received then timescales will shift significantly and could take quite some time to resolve.

Also please note that TransportNI will apply a £1,000.00 charge plus all costs for the abandonment and you /your client will be asked to pay in advance. Before the process begins i will send you a form for authorisation and return with accompanying cheque payable to "TransportNI.

I am contacting you to request the abandonment of a track in the Gortin and Greencastle area. We have been advised by the Sectional Engineer for the area that Hoy Dorman should contact you to progress the abandonment process. We have met with TNI on several occasions where they have stated that they are firmly in favour of the

aba nment taking place. For your information our clients who wish to abandon the track are in control of all the surrounding lands.


