

- I notice a slight difference in your DfI Roads drawing relating to the location of the east stop up point. On the left below is the HD location, on the right is Roads location, just wondering is there a reason for this? Our location on the left is at the scheme fence line. Same at the west side there is a slight difference at the stopped up location when comparing Roads 2016 to draft 2020.
