Attending and viewing the pre-inquiry meeting

[1] This publication is intended to inform and assist all those who intend to participate in or observe the Curraghinalt Project (Dalradian) pre-inquiry meeting which will be held at 10.30 am on Wednesday 20th March 2024 in the <u>Strule Arts Centre, Omagh, Co. Tyrone</u>.

[2] The Commission has selected this venue due to its proximity to the project site to accommodate local residents to attend.

[3] The proceedings will be live streamed online at the Commission's YouTube channel for anyone who wishes to view remotely. A link to the live stream will be made available on the Commission's website before the meeting commences. Please note the live stream will only become available at the start of the inquiry meeting at approximately 10.30am.

[4] Parties who wish to attend in person will be admitted <u>up to the capacity of the venue</u>.

[5] Once the venue is at capacity no further parties will be admitted.

[6] The Commission therefore would encourage anyone <u>who does not intend to speak</u> at the meeting not to attend at the venue and to watch the live stream of the meeting remotely.

Nominating a spokesperson

[9] All parties are reminded that the purpose of this meeting is to outline arrangements to open the eight conjoined inquiries and deal with procedural matters.

[10] There will be no discussion of the merits of the proposals at this meeting.

[11] Entrance to the venue will be via the Bridge Street Entrance. Please note there will

be no admission before 9.45am.

[12] Food and drink will not be permitted in the auditorium for the duration of the meeting.
