I refer to your email of Friday 5th December 2025 relating to the above conjoined public local inquiries. In your email we are now advised that DfI Planning considers Lough's Agency (and others) made a representation to it having provided a transboundary consultation response to Donegal County Council. The Lough's Agency and others were not included in the list provided by DfI to the Commission on 30th May 2025 and have therefore not been included in the request for Statements of Evidence.
