Re: Curraghinalt Project (Dalradian) Conjoined Public Local Inquiry

I refer to the Curraghinalt Project (Dalradian) Conjoined Public Local Inquiries and recent discussion last Thursday in relation to the timetable. Discussion took place regarding the hearing of the Road Abandonment Order and Transport topics on 18, 19, 20 and 21 May 2026. During that discussion it was suggested that DfI Roads could not provide representation for the dates of 20 and 21 May and was uncertain as to the 18 May. Whilst it has become necessary to adjust the order of topics to be heard, the dates themselves have been part of the timetable from the outset.

The Commission would expect that DfI Roads, a government department and the referring body in respect of the Roads Abandonment Order application, would be able to and should provide a representative for all of the relevant dates.
