Matter Arising 21

- 1. In response to question 3 of topic 17 (Strategic Housing Allocation Strategy), the Council provided the figures for the 2012-based, 2014-based, 2016-based, and 2018-based population projections for Mid and East Antrim from the Northern Ireland Statistics and Research Agency and compared these with the 2020 mid-year population estimates. It did so in order to demonstrate that the population projections relied on were broadly in line with the latest population estimate. Commissioner Daly invited the Council to submit this information in writing along with a graph comparing the population projections with the population estimate.
